

Student Group Road Map (Digestible Version)

Step 1 - No earlier than March 29th

Student group activity remains online or self led* for activities for household or individuals

Society/club members can meet socially in groups of 6 outside in line with and spirit of government guidelines. But the roadmap doesn't currently allow organised events for community/university groups

Organised outdoor sports club or other approved society activities in line with NGB guidance - can go ahead

Return of some outdoor UEA Sport activities e.g. dog walking etc. Sports park outdoor facilities bookings available for on campus households

Step 2 - From April the 30th until 17th May

Student groups may meet in up to groups of 15, to undertake their **core activity** in a COVID secure way as defined by government or SU guidance, if that activity cannot be reasonably done virtually

All activities to be outside only and on campus, unless there is specific government or NGB guidance to say that it can take place indoors or off campus.

Student groups however are not authorised to organise purely social gatherings for their club or society.

Society/club members can meet socially with friends that is not an organised club or society activity in groups of 6 outside in line with and in spirit of government guidelines.

Organised outdoor sports club in line with NGB guidance can go ahead

Sports Park gym will reopen for household and individual training

The SU, on the assumption that the government road map is on schedule, will ask student groups for proposed activities to be held no earlier than the 17th of May with required safety documentation to be filled in.

Re-Open with capacity restriction the Media Centre rooms - from the 26th of April

Step 3 - No Earlier than 17th of May

Return of COVID Secure **core activity** for student groups where guidance allows in a COVID secure way as defined by government or SU guidance.

Mandatory COVID Secure Training Refreshers will be put on by the SU for student groups.

Student groups however are not authorised to organise purely social gatherings for their club or society.

Application of the rule of 6 at any indoor activities and capacity restrictions

Max capacity of 30 for any COVID secure outdoor events organised by student groups if attendance numbers can be effectively managed

Society/club members can meet socially with friends that is not an organised club or society activity in groups of 6 inside or 30 outside in line with and in spirit of government guidelines.

Organised indoor sports club activity to return in line with NGB guidance.

Organised outdoor sports club activity to continue in line with NGB guidance.

All other activities with approved NGB guidance from government can return.

Some opportunity for outdoor performances.

Return of in person SU events, training sessions etc. where appropriate.

Further easing of capacity restriction on Media centre.

Step 4 - No earlier than 21st of June

Further easing of restrictions on student group activity

Return of further in person SU events

Ability for student groups to go on trips in local area - international group travel will not be approved

SU and UEA Sport programme of activities for 4 week rent extension

To note:

At all times student groups should actively encourage members to continue the basics of staying safe

- Washing hands, covering Face, keeping distance, regularly testing, following the guidance on isolation

All timelines and easing of restrictions are subject to government guidance. Where we can ease restrictions we will look to at each stage

During any stage should you be unsure of activity please contact the SU Opportunities team or UEA Sport for clarification before planning

Please at all stages take severe caution when signing any contract or outlaying of funds for activities linked to a change in step

*Definition of Self Led – This is an activity which is organised and promoted by a student group. But is undertaken by individuals or by household groups in line with government guidance. This may include a virtual 5k, a guided walk or individual fundraising activities

Definition of online – All social elements of the activity are done via technological software.

This roadmap will be reviewed at each stage the government releasing further guidance. This may be short notice and could at points mean a reversal back to restrictions if required.
